The Codington County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m., Thursday, June 5, 2014, at the Codington County Courthouse. Commission members present were: George Heller, Tyler McElhany, Myron Johnson, and Brenda Hanten; Elmer Brinkman absent; Vice-Chair Hanten presiding.

**AGENDA APPROVED**

Motion by McElhany, second by Heller, to approve the agenda, all present voted aye; motion carried.

**2014 PRIMARY ELECTION CANVASS**

The Board conducted the canvass of the vote totals for the 2014 Primary Election, held in Codington County, on Tuesday, the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 2014. Motion by Johnson, second by McElhany, to approve the results of the 2014 Primary Election as presented by the Auditor; all present voted aye; motion carried.

**LIQUOR LICENSE TRANSFER APPLICATION/PUBLIC HEARING**

The Board held a public hearing on an application for a one day transfer of the Rauville Station liquor license to a private residence location for a wedding reception. Sheriff Toby Wishard addressed the Board and asked that the Board add the following stipulations to the approval of the transfer application:

1. Exact location of the bar on the private property must be disclosed and approved by the Sheriff
2. Exact hours of operation must be disclosed to the Auditor or Sheriff
3. Access to the private property by law enforcement must be allowed at any time during the hours of Operation

Motion by McElhany, second by Johnson, to approve the liquor license transfer application, submitted by Gordon Kliegel d.b.a. Rauville Station, upon the condition that the stipulations as presented by the Sheriff are accepted and provided by the applicant. Commissioner McElhany noted this type of transfer is new to the County and additional requirements from the Planning and Zoning Board could be implemented for future transfer applications of this type. Upon vote of the Board; all present voted aye; motion carried.

**ALLEY VACATED**

The Board noted that Chairman Brinkman has signed a petition to vacate an alley described as: that portion of the East-West alley bordering Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of Block 12 of Davis Addition to the City of Watertown and Lots 1 & 2 of P. and P. addition to the City of Watertown on the South; on behalf of Codington County as an adjacent property owner, to expedite the process to schedule a public hearing before the Watertown City Council on the petition to vacate.

**ADJOURNMENT**

There being no further business to come before the Board a motion was made by Heller, second by Johnson, to adjourn at 9:11 a.m., until 9:00 a.m., Tuesday, June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2014; all present voted aye; motion carried.
