4-H is the largest youth serving organization in the world. Any youth between the ages of 8 to 18 can join 4-H. You can join an existing club or you can start your own 4-H club.

The Codrington County 4-H provides hands-on, real life experiences through projects, activities and events. 4-H members learn new things by completing dozens of different projects. They go on trips, have parties, participate in local government, experiment with science, make art, go to camp or take care of an animal. Youth have the opportunities to learn leadership, citizenship, character and life skills. The cost to join is only \$1.50 or \$2.50 (horse members) to cover 4-H insurance.
