Codington County recognizes the dangers of Coronavirus and is taking measures to ensure safety to the public and its employees. The public is being asked to please refrain from using the Codington County Courthouse if you are experiencing symptoms such as a fever, a cough, and/or shortness of breath if possible. It is further advised if you have any underlying health issues, please refrain from using county buildings and offices. If you need to visit an office in the courthouse, including the Treasurer's Office, please attempt alternatives such as conducting business via phone, mail, and/or fax. Renewals can be done over the phone by contacting the Treasurer's Office, or online by going to MySDcars.sd.gov. All tax payments can be submitted by mail.

If your business needs to be conducted in person, please use social distancing by keeping six feet away from other persons. Remember to wash your hands often, refrain from handshakes, and use hand sanitizer if available. If you do have to conduct business at the Codington County Courthouse, you may see safety precautions being practiced such as social distancing.
